



**Men's Day 2026
Information Package**

Men's Day is played all day every **Tuesday**.

Tee Box Position

Men's Day participants **only use grass tees** (no mats except when posted).

Tee Time Booking

The first Men's Day will be Tuesday April 21, 2026 (weather permitting), with golfers permitted to book their tee times starting April 14th. We will continue to book one week in advance, so each Tuesday you can book for the following week.

- **NEW 2024** Men's Day is an **18 Hole Event**. The cost is \$38.00 for 18 holes (\$28.00 is for green fees and \$10.00 is held for weekly prizes (includes \$ 2 second 9 skins money)).
- There is an optional \$ 2.00 - \$ 10,000 hole in one prize on hole # 9
 - o Minimum of 3 persons to participate **AND** witnessed by employee
- **NEW 2024** All golfers must start on the **FRONT**.
- **After 3:00pm**, Men's Day players have the right of way and if the volume of men dictates it the course will be closed to men only. If volume does **NOT** dictate it then other golfers will be allowed on the golf course.
- Normal procedures will apply as to filling out a foursome with other golfers as needed to best use available tee times.

Scoring and Course rules

Men must record their total strokes for the hole. Any golfer not counting all their strokes **will be disqualified**. All Putts MUST be holed out **NO GIMMIES!** A player is allowed relief from an embedded ball, with the ball placed no closer to the hole. A player is allowed one club length of relief no closer to the hole (or the nearest point of relief) from cart paths, wooden fences, or other manmade objects. Tee shots hit into the gullies on #2, #5, & #17. Use drop zone on other side and count a stroke.

Each golfer must have and record their own score on their own scorecard. It is **imperative** to give your scorecard to another golfer in your group to witness your

score and sign the scorecard after the round. **Only** another Men's Day golfer in your group can sign your scorecard, and each golfer can only sign one card.

To qualify for the hole # 9 \$10,000.00 hole in one. You must have paid the optional \$ 2.00 10K hole in one fee and there must be at least 3 players (18 years or older) in your group. Groups of two are not eligible!

Men's Day Final Tournament

Sunday, September 27, 2026. Dinner and prizes will follow. Everyone is welcome to play in the finale regardless of number of games played. Dinner is **NOT** optional! You must pay and play to be eligible for any prizes.

Prizes (all Weekly Prizes will be cash prizes with exception of the weekly draws)

If you are a returning men's day player and have played in at least three men's days you will have a handicap. This handicap carries forward from the previous year. If you did not play in the previous year. You will have to play three games to establish a handicap. **Handicaps from other golf courses cannot be used.**

Prize money breakdown distribution is listed below.

- \$3.00 **Weekly Prizes** (low gross and net, KP's, LP)
- \$2.00 First 9 skins
- \$1.00 weekly draw (\$10 Alder Hills Gift Certificate)
- \$1.00 Hole in one pot
- \$1.00 Final Tournament prizes
- \$2.00 Second 9 skins only if playing 18 hole men's day

- \$ 2.00 Optional \$ 10,000 Hole in One Insurance for hole # 9

Weekly Prizes (Based on the First 9 holes that week)

KP's – Closest to the Pin

Three KP's are marked out of the first 9 holes each Tuesday.

You must be on the green with your first shot to qualify for a KP.



LP's - Longest Putt

One LP is marked out of the first 9 holes each Tuesday.

Any putt sunk which is longer than any other Men's Day golfer that day, qualifies for the longest putt. You must be on the green for the shot to be considered as a putt. Putting from off the green is not a putt.

Low Gross – Low Net

Prizes are awarded for the lowest gross and net scores

Note: If you win low gross, you are not eligible for low net. If there is a tie, there will be a count back to determine the winner. Our Tournament Scoring software will determine the winner with its countback method.

Weekly Draws

Each week randomly drawn names will be chosen to receive a \$ 10 Gift Certificate. Gift certificates can be used towards anything in the clubhouse except for prize money.

Hole in One Pot

The Hole-In-One Pot will be pro-rated. For example, if there have been 10 Men's Days and you get a Hole-In-One and you have played 5 of the 10 Men's Days, you will receive 5/10ths of the pot, but if you played all 10 of the Men's Day's, you qualify for the entire pot. **Note:** You must card the Hole-In-One on the first nine holes that you are scoring for Men's Day. You must also have the Hole-In-One witnessed by another Men's Day participant in your group. If the Hole-In-One is on a hole with a KP, you do not receive the KP prize. Any leftover hole in one money will be drawn for at the men's day finale.

If you card an ace on the second 9 it does not qualify for the hole in one pot. It does however qualify for the skins pot as that is a skin. Assuming you have taken the optional second 9 skins.

Skins

Each week \$ 2 from each player's prize money goes towards a skins pot for both the front and another \$ 2 for the back 9. To skin a hole, you must win the hole outright. No ties. If there is no skins that week the skin pot will carry forward to the following week.

Low gross and low net is only for the first 9 of play. Second 9 is skins only.

\$10,000 Hole in One Insurance

There is an optional \$ 10,000 hole in one insurance for hole # 9 each week. In order to qualify for the \$ 10,000 hole in one. You must have paid the optional \$ 2 insurance at sign up. You must also be in a group of 3 or more players, and it must be witnessed by an employee of Alder Hills Golf Course. Please call up to the clubhouse prior to hitting your shot and they will come out to witness.

Warm up bucket of balls

Each men's Day participant will receive a free small bucket of balls to warm up with.

Practice Round

Men's day is a tournament and as such a practice round the day of the tournament is strictly prohibited.

Pace of Play

Slow play and delayed tee time are a source of tension and confrontation than can be easily avoid with proper consideration by all golfers. Keep up the pace of play (about seven minutes per hole) or let faster golfers play through. **The procedure for a “play through” on our course is for the slower group to tee off first, and then let the faster group tee off before proceeding past the tee box area.** Then the faster group and the slower group both leave the tee box area at the same time, but the faster group plays the hole out first. In this way the slower group does not fall behind as the next group approaches. Cooperation by both groups benefits both groups and it is a good day for golf.

Note: Prize money cannot be picked up any other day than Tuesday. *All outstanding prizes must be picked up by the last Men's Day, or the money will be added to the Finale prize money.*

NEW 2024 Men's Day is based 18 holes of golf.
